Club Description

All about Animals Reception – Year 2

This club offers a fun way to learn all about animals. Sessions will include story time featuring animal themed books, creative craft activities and simple facts about a wide range of animals, from farm favourites and pets to exotic wildlife. Perfect for young animal enthusiasts who enjoy stories, crafts and learning about the natural world.

Arts and Crafts Reception - Year 2

Each week, your child will have the chance to make, create and explore a variety of different medias and resources.

After School Care Reception - Year 2

This is available from 4:30pm to 5:30pm and looks after those children unable to be collected at 4:30pm. A sandwich/crudité tea is given to the children. These sessions need to be pre-booked but can accommodate children occasionally on an ad-hoc basis.

Ballet Reception - Year 2

Ballet is a fantastic way to learn how to move and control your body. It's often referred to as the foundation of dance and it's easy to see why. It requires commitment and often gets the best results from more than one lesson a week. Practicing ballet can help improve posture and promote graceful movement. It's also incredibly strengthening and contributes to core strength as well as improving flexibility. Learning ballet is a great base to start to learn many other dance forms. Teachers are qualified by the Royal Academy of Dance and offer only the very best for our students at Blundell's.

Building and Lego Club Reception & Year 1

The Building and Lego Club is a fun space where the children can use colourful Lego blocks and other toys to build anything they imagine! They'll explore shapes, sizes, and creative ideas while having fun with friends in a safe, exciting environment.

Choir Reception – Year 2

Mrs Chalk is excited to launch our brand-new Pre-Prep Choir! This will give our youngest pupils the chance to explore music through singing, rhythm and movement. The children will learn fun songs, develop their listening and vocal skills and build confidence while working together as a team.

Coding Club - Year 2

Coding club is a fun iPad-based club which will develop coding skills using the visual programme 'Scratch'. There will be lots of fun creating animated characters, videos and stories.

Construction Club Reception - Year 2

Construction Club is a creative and hands-on group where LEGO bricks, Play-Doh and other construction toys will be used to build, shape and design.

Drawing & Colouring Reception & Year 1

This is a relaxing club exploring different ways of drawing and colouring.

Extended Care Reception - Year 2

This is available from 5:30pm – 6:00pm for those children who cannot be picked up at 5:30pm

Fiddle Time Fun Year 2

Fiddle Time Fun is aimed at our Year 2 pupils in the Pre-Prep. Mrs Smith and Mrs Cracknell will be taking these sessions, the aim of which is to introduce our younger pupils to the Violin through musical games and activities in a disciplined, supportive and fun learning environment. There will be a maximum of 8 places available for this club on a first come first served basis.

Football Year 1 & Year 2

We are delighted to welcome Exeter City Community Trust in association with Exeter Football Club. Although fun is important, skills are honed and teamwork is an essential element of this sport.

Funky Jazz Year 1 & Year 2

Funky Jazz is a relaxed and fun class. Within the lessons the use of free music (top 40 hits and Disney songs) allows our Funky Jazzers to be more individual and express themselves through movement and games. There is more to it than just Jazz Hands!

Games Year 1 & Year 2

This club takes a specific sport each term and concentrates on teamwork, skills and the rules. Perhaps the most important part of the club though is the emphasis on fun and the sense of joy in playing.

J-Team Reception – Year 2

J-Team is the School's Christian Union. Children enjoy taking part in games, stories and singing together.

Judo Year 1 & Year 2

The children have expert instruction by a 4th Dan. They take part in gradings each term which allows the children to progress through the different levels of Judo. They also are invited to take part in the UBA championships each year. This is a highly disciplined club and children should commit to the club for a full year as it is a progressive programme of learning.

Library Reception – Year 1

Storytime club is a club where children will read a range of different stories and enjoy activities such as drawing, writing, crafting or drama linked to the book that week.

Rest & Relax - Reception

A quiet time for our early years children to come together to play, read and carry out calming activities.

Scrumkids Reception - Year 2

This exciting club will be run by the specialist team from Scrumkids, Devon. The focus will be on bringing together the skills for tag rugby, which both our girls and boys play here in the Pre-Prep.

Sewing Year 1 & Year 2

This club will develop hand eye coordination, as well as encouraging creativity. All children will learn to thread a needle and sew useful objects such as a bookmark. Having fun and enjoyment will be a key factor.

Skipping Year 1 & Year 2

Learning to skip is fun! It's also great exercise and everyone – boy or girl, young or old can do it. In skipping club, we will focus on getting the basics right to begin with, such as rope turning and jumping with the correct rhythm and balance. Once we have mastered this, we will progress to learning a few tricks and skipping in time to music. The children will be provided with a high-quality gymnastic speed skipping rope.

Year 2 In Class Care Year 2

This club is for Year 2 children who return to school around 4.00pm after going to swimming on a Thursday afternoon. They will be taking part in various activities with their friends in their classroom.
